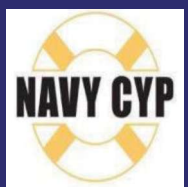

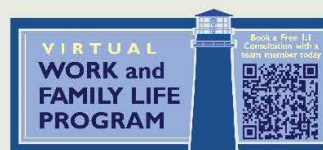

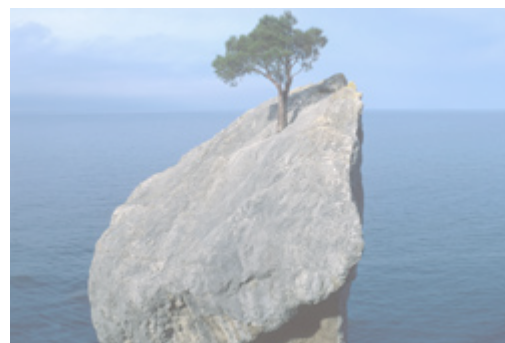

The CFS plays an integral role in promoting financial readiness. This training provides CFS candidates with the knowledge to manage their command's Personal Financial Management Program.

The new roadmap to becoming a CFS is now separated into two parts.

Part One — Complete *Million Dollar Sailor*



WHEN: December 1-2, 2025 0800-1600

This two-day course provides the foundational knowledge in personal financial concepts.

The course is open to active duty service members as well as anyone in the community interested in boosting their financial knowledge.

Part Two — Complete *Command Financial Specialist*



WHEN: December 3-5, 2025 0800-1600

Complete the Command Financial Specialist training. These three days continue the candidate on the road to becoming a CFS by providing counseling techniques, information and referral options and presentation strategies.

This course is only open to active duty service members. Candidates must be E-5 and above, have one year remaining at command, and be highly motivated and financially stable (must meet the financial overseas screening; completed by the command prior to registration)

All service members are required to attend a Capstone Event a minimum of 90 days prior to their separation/retirement date.
