Subj: RETIREMENT GOLF TOURNAMENT / WARDROOM HAIL & FAREWELL

Encl: (1) Schedule of Events

- 1. <u>Purpose</u>. To promulgate information and assigned responsibilities regarding the retirement celebration in honor of CWO3 Brian Curran and the Naval Support Activity, Naples, Italy (NSA Naples) Command Wardroom Hail and Farewell event to be held at Carney Park on 11 April 2025 from 1100 to 1700.
- 2. <u>Background</u>. CWO3 Curran will retire from the United States Navy after 23 years of honorable service on 01 June 2025. There will be a brief speech/kickoff ceremony held at the Carney Park Clubhouse on 11 April 2025 at 1100 and will be followed by an 18-Hole Best Ball Scramble Golf Tournament and subsequent reception.

NOTE: Foul Weather. Rain will not stop any activities except those requiring electrical equipment. All other events will continue as planned unless severe weather develops.

- 3. Uniform. Civilian golfing attire.
- 4. Action.
 - a. The Invocation/Benediction will be provided by Chaplain Hostetler.
- b. The Commanding Officer will preside over the kickoff ceremony with all guests (golfers) in their carts and ready to transit to their assigned starting holes.
 - c. The Public Affairs Department will provide photography services.
 - d. Ms. Annunziata Arpante will sing the National Anthem.
 - e. The NSA Naples Color Guard will parade the colors.
- f. The Community Liaison will coordinate catering services for the reception. Alcohol consumption is permitted in moderation. Hard liquor is prohibited.

- g. Following the golf event, the NSA Naples Wardroom will hold a Hail and Farewell ceremony and provide farewell gifts to the departing members. Golf participants are encouraged to stay and enjoy food and drink.
- h. MWR Golf will hold the course for the event. Also, they will collect scorecards after the event and announce the winning teams for first, second, and third place.
 - i. The WRA will sell Mulligan Tickets at a cost of 10 euros (max 4 per person).
- j. Sign-up and RSVP will be directly to the retiree and event coordinator at the point of contact below. Cost of golf will be the responsibility of each individual golfer to be paid directly to the golf course on the day of the event. **Sign-up will close on 14 March 2025.**

5. Golf Tournament

- a. <u>Texas Scramble Format</u>. The players or designated team captain decide after each shot which one is the best shot. To start, each player hits a shot off the tee on every hole. After designating the best shot, each player on the team plays their next shot from that spot; within one club length no closer to the hole.
- b. <u>Shotgun Start</u>. All the players in a tournament begin playing at the same time, but from a different place on the course. Each player will start at a different hole when the tournament begins and the players will continue along the course in order from the hole where they began.
- c. <u>Capacity and Teams</u>. Due to the course only having nine holes, the teams will be split into foursomes and the maximum number of players on the course will be two foursomes at each hole (max. 72 golfers + 72 caddies = 144 total). Each foursome will designate a team captain prior to beginning the event. Each team must have a minimum of at least three players.

d. Rules.

- (1) For shots off of the green, each player must play within a club length of where the ball came to rest.
- (2) For shots on the green, each player must play within a putter's head of where the ball came to rest. Teams usually leave a mark close to where the ball stopped to assist with spotting the ball.
- (3) No mulligans allowed unless purchased from the WRA by individual members or teams.
- (4) Each player on a team must use a minimum of two drives each per nine holes played, four drives per player for the tournament.

- e. <u>Non-federal Entity (NFE) Participation</u>. NFE's are encouraged to participate and hold internal fundraising competition (closest to the pin, longest drive, most accurate drive, longest putt, etc.).
- f. MWR. MWR will be responsible for providing all necessary equipment; to include, grills, canopy, tables, chairs, and sports equipment, and will coordinate beer sales for the event.
