Subj: NOTICE OF RESTRICTION OF MOVEMENT (ROM)/QUARANTINE (V3, 3 MAY 2020)

1. The U.S. Government has declared a public health emergency in response to the coronavirus disease (COVID-19). In accordance with the U.S. Department of Defense, U.S. Navy, and/or Quarantine Designation by the Government of Bahrain, this is a formal notice that you are designated as an individual subject to Restriction of Movement (ROM). As the installation commander, I am ordering your compliance with ROM/Quarantine guidance. I am providing you with the following directions and information regarding ROM/Quarantine.


2. Quarantine can help limit the spread of communicable disease. Quarantine is used to separate and restrict the movement of well persons who may have been exposed to a communicable disease to see if they become ill. These people may have been exposed to a disease and do not know it, or may have the disease but do not show symptoms. Quarantine separates and restricts the movement of people who were potentially exposed to a contagious disease to see if they become sick.

3. At minimum, the following guidance is provided:

- DO NOT leave your room or domicile for any reason other than life safety (e.g. fire).
- DO NOT visit common areas (e.g. lounge, lobby, gym, front desk/reception).
- DO NOT allow visitors of any kind into the quarters including cleaning staff.
- If returning from leave, quarantine will be in your flat or villa. If family members or roommates are present in the domicile, quarantine must be completed in separate room of the house and the individual must have his/her own restroom facility. Commands may make special arrangements, to include providing funded orders for lodging.
- Your chain of command is responsible for assisting you with getting food and basic necessities. If you have concerns or issues with care and feeding, contact the NSA Bahrain CDO at 3940-3877.
- If symptoms develop or you suspect you have the disease, call for assistance:
 - On base: 1785-4911 from a cell phone or 911 from a DSN
 - Off base: 4-4-4, follow up with your chain of command and base 911 call center
 - Notify your command who will notify the EOC at 1785-8881 or DSN: 439-8881.
- Bahrain requires a second COVID-19 test 14 days after your original test, and you must be negative before being released from quarantine.
 - Work with your command to schedule an appointment (most likely at the drive through testing center at the Exhibition Center). Bring the same form(s) of ID used at immigration when you arrived (e.g., passport, DOD ID, CPR).
 - Return to quarantine in your room or domicile until test results come back. If negative test result, you may be released from quarantine. If positive, expect MOH ambulance to transport to host nation medical isolation facility.

4. You are ordered to follow the following guidance provided with this order:

5. Military members must comply with ROM/Quarantine. Per USCENTCOM 300123Z APR 20, failure to do so will result in an additional 14 days of ROM/quarantine and may subject you to punitive or administrative measures. For civilian (to include all categories of employment with DoD) and DoD dependents, purposefully breaking Bahrain's order to quarantine is a violation of Bahraini law. Further, failure to abide by directed quarantine may result in adverse administrative action including loss of command sponsorship, early return of dependents, and/or disciplinary action for federal employees. Qualifying days of quarantine must be consecutive without a break. Any individual that breaks quarantine, must restart the quarantine period with the first new qualifying day beginning the following day.
6. Any individual subject to ROM/Quarantine has the right to contest the reason for ROM/quarantine. Information supporting exemption or release can be provided to me or one of my designated representatives. I (or a designated representative) will review the information provided, in consultation with public health, medical, and legal personnel, for a final determination on the need for quarantine. The total time from submission to response will not exceed 24 hours.
7. Procedures for the declaration of a public health emergency, quarantine, and the actions prescribed above are found in Department of Defense Instruction 6200.03, "Public Health Emergency Management (PHEM) Within the DoD." It is DoD and U.S. Navy policy that military installations, property, and personnel and other individuals working or residing on military installations will be protected under applicable legal authorities against communicable diseases associated with biological warfare or terrorism or other public health emergency. Violators of procedures, protocols, provisions, or orders detailed in this memorandum may be charged with a crime under Section 271 of Title 42, United States Code, and subject to punishment of a fine up to \$1,000 or imprisonment for not more than one year, or both.
8. A wide range of professionals are working hard to bring this situation to a resolution that supports your health and the safety of the general public. Thank you for your cooperation and compliance in this matter.
