LOST OR STOLEN COVER PLATES Even if only one plate is missing

PROCEDURAL STEPS

• <u>US members (including personnel assigned to Joint Forces Command):</u>

- Immediately report to NSA Naples Security I-7 (081 568 5549 / 3351328613) who will contact the Carabinieri and set up an appointment to file a report on the circumstances surrounding the lost/stolen Italian cover plate/plates to avoid any consequences in case the missing plate(s) is being used illegally.
- AFI vehicle owners will be escorted by I-7 to local Carabinieri office to file a Denouncement. Ensure you have a copy of your vehicle registration (copies can be provided by MVRO).
- If the plate(s) goes missing on Capo or Support Site bases also report to NSA Naples Security to file a report on the lost/stolen Italian cover plate/plates (DSN 626-2207 / 629-4269).

NON US members

- Immediately file a Carabinieri Denouncement at the Joint Forces Command's Carabinieri station or any Carabinieri station to avoid any consequences in case the missing plate(s) is being used illegally.
- **DO NOT DELAY REPORTING**! You are accountable/responsible for the custody and control of the plates until properly reported to the Carabinieri/Italian Police and NSA Security (if applicable).
- Please ensure that the Carabinieri Denouncement includes: the vehicle owner's name, the lost/stolen cover plate number and AFI number, the vehicle make/model/year/VIN and ensure to specify if both plates or only one plate and which one (front or rear) was lost/stolen, date of plate loss/theft. Your denouncement must include this information which must also be correct or you will be required to file another denouncement.

DISTRIBUTION OF DENOUNCEMENT

- You MUST provide the ORIGINAL Denouncement to MVRO so we can clear your records with the local Motorizzazione (DMV) and Italian Ministry of Transport!
- The denouncement is used as the source document to:
 - Assign a new set of Italian Cover Plates.
 - o Issue a new AFI Vehicle Registration and Certificate of Title
 - Change your Tax-free fuel privileges.
 If missing plate belongs to a primary vehicle, NATO members at JFC are to return their yellow gas card to MVRO so a new one with the new plate number can be issued.
 - During the Re-registration process, your insurance company will need to issue a new Certificate of Insurance and may need a copy of the denouncement for their records.
 - Keep a copy of the Denouncement for your records.

IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT THE PROCESS

• IF THE MISSING PLATE IS RECOVERED PLEASE RETURN IT TO MVRO IMMEDIATELY

- If you have a NEX "Telepass", please report the loss to the NEX Personal Services Office (commercial: 081-813-5321) immediately
- Driving with only one or no plate on a vehicle could get your car impounded if stopped by Italian police.
