3. Roles and Responsibilities

a. The Fleet and Family Support Center (FFSC) Ombudsman Coordinator, Ms. Tonya Douce, and FFSC Work and Family Life (WFL) Supervisor, Mr. Angel Rivera, shall assign roles (i.e. guest speaker, event coordinator, etc.), secure venue and meal selections for event, submit Military Working Dog request and Special Event Anti-Terrorism Plan to NSA Naples Security Office for approval by Regional Commander, ensure proper support is required for requesting NAVEUR-NAVAF Band and NSA Naples Chaplain, organize seating arrangements of guests, secure podium for event, secure microphone and speaker for event, create invitations and eInvite, and select "award" for Ombudsmen. They shall draft the agenda, program for event, and provide certificates to be printed and signed by the NSA Naples Commanding Officer.

b. NSA Naples Protocol Officer shall send formal invitations to Flag Officers and Executive Directors that include the meal option information and assist with securing a venue for the event.

c. NSA Naples Public Affairs Office shall provide escort and one MC rated Petty Officer to cover for official pictures and social media.

d. NSA Naples Command Secretary shall send the invitation with meal option information to tenant command leadership, department heads, and support organizations.

e. NSA Naples Commanding Officer's Administrative Staff and the FFSC Area Orientation Staff will oversee ticket sales and receipt of cash monies for the event.

f. NSA Naples Deputy Command Chaplain, LCDR David Hostetler, will provide the invocation and benediction for event.

g. Command Master Chief Darin Vazquez shall secure the United States Navy, Italian, and United States of America ceremonial flags.

4. Uniform. Business casual attire (no jackets) for all participants.

United States Navy Biography

FLTCM (SW) Johannes J. Gonzalez Fleet Master Chief, U.S. Naval Forces Europe & Africa

Fleet Master Chief Gonzalez was born and raised in Panama, Republic of Panama. He immigrated to the United States at the age of 16, and realized his dream of joining the U. S. military at the age of 24 after obtaining his permanent resident status. Fleet Gonzalez reported to Recruit Training Command, Great Lakes, Illinois, in 1995 and began his career as a Fireman Recruit. After graduating basic training, he attended Gas Turbine Systems Technician (Electrical) class "A" school, then later converted to the Navy Counselor rating. Gonzalez proudly became a United States naturalized citizen through his military service in 1998. He was selected for the Command Senior Chief Program in 2011 and for Command Master Chief in 2012.

At Sea, he served onboard the USS Kidd (DDG 993), USS Donald Cook (DDG 75), USS Vincennes (CG 49),

USS Lake Erie (CG 70), and the USS Reuben James (FFG 57).

His shore tours include NCTAMS Pacific, U.S. Naval Forces Japan, Naval Base Guam, U.S. Fourth Fleet, U.S. Sixth Fleet, and Naval Leadership and Ethics Center. Gonzalez is a graduate of the U.S. Navy Senior Enlisted Academy (Class 142/Khaki), CMC/COB Course (Class 83), the National Defense University Keystone Joint Command Senior Enlisted Course, and the Naval Postgraduate School Navy Senior Leader Seminar.

He has served on teams that have been recognized with numerous awards. His most precious ones are the Battle Effectiveness Awards earned with Teammates while at sea. Gonzalez assumed the duties as the Fleet Master Chief for U. S. Naval Forces Europe and Africa in June of 2022.
