### NAVSUPPACT NAPLES INSTRUCTION 11000.3

Subj: NAVAL SUPPORT ACTIVITY NAPLES ZONE INSPECTION PROGRAM

1. Purpose. To establish command policy and assign responsibilities for the implementation and administration of the Zone Inspection Program per reference (a). The Zone Inspection Program will ensure that all facilities are maintained in a safe and functional condition per reference (b).

2. Scope. This instruction applies to all U.S. Naval Support Activity (NAVSUPPACT), Naples, Italy facilities to include leased facilities, and requires participation from all NAVSUPPACT Naples departments and tenant commands regardless of military service or resource sponsor.

#### 3. Background

a. Zone inspections are an inherent tool for assessing base appearance, facility condition, and facility configuration to document and facilitate proper operability, cleanliness, and state of preservation. The Zone Inspection program enables the proper prioritization of NAVSUPPACT Naples resources and investment in installation facilities.

b. Establishing an installation-wide program is essential to ensuring that NAVSUPPACT Naples remains capable of supporting the Warfighter in the execution of their mission. The effectiveness of this program relies on the active involvement of all tenant commands regardless of military service or resource sponsor to ensure discrepancies are found, documented, prioritized, and corrected in a timely manner. This effort requires consistent active involvement of the entire chain of command to meet mission critical functions, and to ensure the best possible appearance to all base occupants and visitors.

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c. NAVSUPPACT Naples provides tenant commands with facilities and common support base operating services in support of their mission. Inherent as part of any host-tenant agreement are basic tenant responsibilities to include building oversight, cleanliness, and assignment of a Building Manager (BM), Emergency Manager (EM), and Building Energy Monitor (BEM).

4. Policy

a. Zones are geographically sub-divided areas of the installation. Zone designation and inspection schedule will be distributed each year by the BM for the following calendar year. Every NAVSUPPACT Naples facility shall be inspected at least once annually.

b. The primary focus of zone inspections is major components, functionality, and safety items. Specific aspects to be reviewed as part of the zone inspection are listed below:

(1) Housekeeping. Identify equipment and materials not stowed properly or inadequately safeguarded. Special consideration should be given to general organization of materials, orderly appearance, continued need of supplies, and understanding of expiration dates, where applicable.

(2) Safety. Identify safety deficiencies per reference (c) and fire hazards (e.g., space heaters) for programmed correction. Secure equipment, operations, or areas that are considered hazardous or life threatening.

(3) Hazmat and waste. Identify hazardous material and waste stowage or operational processes that pose a threat to the environment. Special consideration should be given to storage facilities, re-use of items, and disposal criteria.

(4) Facility condition. Identify maintenance deficiencies in facilities or structures that must be corrected. Special consideration should be given to the building envelope (e.g., roof as visible from the ground, walls, windows, doors), serviceability of pavements, traffic control markings, signage, and base signage.

(5) Exterior appearance. Special consideration should be given to appearance of common bulletin boards, limiting personal signage, known exterior light issues, entry control points, removal of unneeded bollards, rubber cones, construction fencing, signage, pallets, trip hazards, etc.

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(6) Interior appearance. Identify material condition and configuration of facilities that require correction. Special consideration should be given to restrooms, energy conservation (e.g., use of personal appliances, thermostat settings), and intended space occupancy. This includes evaluating if the occupant's footprint has increased because of the availability of unoccupied areas.

(7) Contractor performance. Identify situations where the contractor performing functions (e.g., janitorial, preventative maintenance, grounds, etc.) may not be meeting contractual performance standards.

(8) Security. Identify security deficiencies for the handling/stowage of information, anti-terrorism criteria, and physical security of the facility.

c. The zone inspection program does not replace any existing facility, health, hygiene, safety and/or fire inspection. It is designed to enhance the installation's professional appearance, safety, management of repairs and oversight of the contractor performance evaluation process. However, the NAVSUPPACT Naples CO has the option to combine with other programs when it is determined to enhance efficiency.

## 5. Responsibilities

a. NAVSUPPACT Naples CO, shall:

(1) Have overall responsibility for oversight, maintenance, and repair actions for facilities and structures within their area of responsibility.

(2) Actively participate in zone inspections.

(3) Brief all tenant commands periodically on the requirements of tenant responsibilities to include building oversight, cleanliness, energy conservation, emergency management, and zone inspection programs.

(4) Designate an Installation Zone Inspection Coordinator and Assistant Zone Inspector Coordinator, in writing, with responsibilities as noted in paragraph 5.e below. These individuals should be of suitable seniority and experience to coordinate this comprehensive program across the entire installation to include remote sites and coordinate with tenant commands as required.

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(5) Designate in writing a building manager(s) for each NAVSUPPACT Naples facility. Building managers will be provided by the command or department using the preponderance of the facility. Some larger, multi-tenant facilities may also require the designation of more than one building managers. Building managers shall be E-7 or above or equivalent civilian grade/experience. Enclosure (1) of this instruction satisfies the building managers designation requirement.

b. Executive Officer (XO), shall ensure that all safety and misuse related discrepancies are corrected in a timely manner.

c. Command Master Chief (CMC), shall:

(1) Be responsible for the overall cleanliness of facilities and surrounding grounds.

(2) Coordinate with tenant commands as needed.

d. Public Works Officer (PWO), shall:

(1) Have overall responsibility for the oversight, maintenance, training and reporting of repair actions for facilities and structures within NAVSUPPACT Naples.

(2) Ensure proper prioritization of all facility-related zone inspection corrective actions with existing service call efforts in MAXIMO.

(3) Request and compile, on behalf of the NAVSUPPACT CO, technical assistance, energy consumption data, property record cards, space usage data sheet, MAXIMO and other facility-related information, as required.

e. Installation Zone Inspection Coordinator shall:

(1) Track and report on the correction of non-facility (safety and misuse) discrepancies to the NAVSUPPACT Naples XO.

(2) Maintain an auditable record indicating that all facilities and spaces have been inspected at least annually. Retain the records for a period of three years.

(3) Identify sub-areas, within NAVSUPPACT Naples for use as zones. Each zone designation will include a lead department or tenant command(s) and building manager responsible for this particular zone, as appropriate.

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(4) Develop and publish an annual schedule for spot zone inspections with as a minimum, CO, XO, CMC. Tenant command leadership (e.g., CO, XO, CMDCM, DHs) and their assigned building manager are also expected to participate in spot zone inspections to ensure the program is fixing discrepancies. All facilities should be reviewed at least once annually.

(5) In coordination with NAVSUPPACT Naples Tenant Commands, develop, publish, and update not less than annually a list of Building Managers.

(6) Provide previous Zone Inspection Deficiency Lists for review by the NAVSUPPACT NAVSUPPACT CO and inspecting team leaders.

e. Building Managers shall:

(1) Develop and publish a yearly schedule for every space under their responsibility to be inspected by key leaders in their commands. This annual schedule shall be provided to the Installation Zone Inspection Coordinator.

(2) Compile and list all known building deficiencies not yet submitted for correction, recurring problems, and potential corrections. Bring this list as part of the zone inspection of the building to share with the inspection team and submit the discrepancy list to the appropriate Maintenance Service Representatives (MSR) listed in enclosure (2).

(3) Submit all identified deficiencies for correction within five business days following the zone inspection to the responsible MSR and track to completion.

f. NAVSUPPACT Naples tenants shall:

(1) Ensure subordinates are familiar with the Zone Inspection Program, and support the Installation in its efforts to facilitate proper operability, cleanliness, and state of preservation.

(2) Coordinate with assigned Building Manager to report and correct any known deficiencies within the tenant's facility or zone.

(3) If the tenant is the predominant user of a facility, identify and provide an Officer, Chief Petty Officer, or appropriate senior civilian to be designated as Building Manager by the Base CO.

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(4) Ensure the Installation Zone Inspection Coordinator is informed of changes to the assignment of Building Managers (e.g., due to PCS/turnover/re-assignment).


