Housing Service Center

A few years ago, there were safety cables installed on the windows to limit the openings. Was that supposed to be for all floors or just the higher apartments?

- The requirement for Window Fall Prevention Safety Devices applies only to windows with sills higher than 72 inches above the exterior ground. The ground floor windows at the Support Site do not meet this criterion, and therefore, the safety devices were not installed.
