

Qualifications of a CFS

The command financial specialist must function as the command's principal advisor on policies and matters related to personal financial management.

They should be:

- -Pay grade E-6 and above including officers or an E-5 with at least of 6 years of service
- -Highly motivated and financially stable (must meet the financial overseas screening)
- -Have at least 1 year remaining in the command at the time of course completion





Grant Program for Military Members

Aligning with the American Red Cross mission of helping military members prepare for, cope with, and respond to the challenges of military service, Service to the Armed Forces (SAF) is implementing the OCONUS Emergency Travel Assistance Grant.

This program will provide financial assistance to military members, including National Guard and Reserve, actively serving Foreign Outside the Continental United States (F-OCONUS) who are currently on or about to begin emergency leave. All categories of emergency leave are eligible for this grant. Service members must provide a copy of their emergency leave orders. Eligible service members will be awarded a \$500 grant.

The OCONUS Emergency Travel Assistance Grant will be available for a limited time based on the availability of funds.

Housing Policy Update

For On-Base Residents with Fully Electric Vehicles

We've heard your concerns regarding the challenges of owning fully electric vehicles under the current housing policy. We appreciate your feedback and are excited to announce that we are updating this policy to better address your needs.

For those that have previously submitted an exception to policy request related to charging vehicles on base, the Housing team will be in touch soon to discuss the option of relocating to economy housing. We are dedicated to supporting our residents throughout this transition and encourage you to reach out to us directly at naples_housing@us.navy.mil with any questions.

Required Documents to submit Exception to Policy:

- 1. Proof of PCS with vehicle from VPC
- 2. Proof of vehicle specifications, including full EV, partial electric vehicles do not fit this criteria.
- 3. Proof of registration with MVRO or a Signed memo stating intentions to register and maintain ownership of the vehicle throughout the duration of the tour.
