## HRO/N91

Is there a way to categorize advertised jobs as temporary or short-term so the position can be filled quicker?

- Unfortunately, all positions (permanent or temporary), go through the same process.

Can we ensure that hiring fairs show jobs that the different offices have available and open?

- There will be specific CYP-focused Job Fairs on the Support Site on Aug. 29<sup>th</sup> and Sep. 24<sup>th</sup>, from 0900-1200.
- Region N1 is promoting a Hiring Fair at the Support Site, TBD date in September, that will include up to 30 different positions across different departments.
- FFSC will host a job fair at Support Site in October (date TBD) that will include over 20 organizations.

## Security/Safety

Is there an ongoing discussion with local authorities regarding new rules for helmets and insurance for two-wheeled cycling?

- A proposal with regards to powered transportation devices and license plates, helmets and insurance, has been discussed within the Italian legislature and is being reviewed. No additional or definitive information is available at this time.

Will bikes need to be registered with MVRO?

- Any motorized vehicle, including two-wheeled vehicles, are required to be registered with MVRO.
- Currently, bicycles are not required to be registered with MVRO.

- Yes, we have approved project w/ funding to do that. We are currently awaiting permit approval to have Mirabella finish the work on the shade structures.

## NEX

Has an effort been made to run QA on the auto repair shop to confirm or eliminate concerns that routine repairs are not properly being done?

- There have multiple QA assessments and tests done with the Auto Port.
- All work and parts come with a 3-month warranty as long as you bring the vehicle back to the Autoport.
- Claims against the Autoport are less than 1% than all work performed in the Auto Port on a yearly basis.

Is there a reliable off-base alternative vehicle maintenance and repair facility to provide regular service or repairs to your vehicle if the NEX auto body shop cannot determine the problem, or it is beyond their scope of knowledge or ability?

- The contractor we have on site was the highest recommended in the economy before coming to NSA Naples more than 15 years ago. Most work on American cars can be timely based on parts.
- Each situation is different and depending on the age and condition of the car, there may be cause for concern on behalf of the contractor to perform work on that vehicle. If the maker of your vehicle has a dealership in the economy, that is a safer bet than another auto repair shop.
