Easter Eggstravaganza / FESTA / SpookTACKular Access

- Access to the events: OPEN AND FREE to all US military ID card-holders, US Contractor ID card-holders, Local National and JFC Carney Park Access Card Holders, family members printed on the back of LN/LN Carney Park Access cards and Support Site House Guest Pass Holders . All of these but the Support Site House Guest Pass Holders are eligible patrons and allowed to sponsor guests into the event for \$10.00 per wristband based on the following policies:
- US MILITARY/CONTRACTOR ID card-holders - up to 4 guests per adult ID card (over 18)
- LN Carney Park Access Card Holders - up to 4 guests per Carney Park Access Card ID (over 18)
- JFC Carney Park Privilege card-holders - up to 4 guests per adult ID Card (over 18)
- Guest access wrist bands are not required for children 4 and younger.
- Guests do not need to be with their sponsors for entry, but guest must have wristbands on their wrist before the first checkpoint into Carney Park
- Guest access wristbands will be available to purchase and pick-up at the S.Site, and Capo Ticket and Travel Offices and Carney Park, during normal hours. Guest access wristbands will cost \$10.00.
- No individual will be admitted to Carney Park without an ID or guest access wristband.

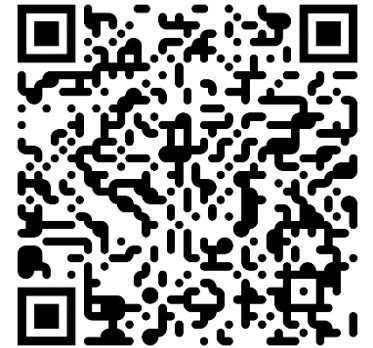

VIRTUAL WORK AND FAMILY LIFE

Welcome to the Fleet and Family Support Program's virtual Work and Family Life (vWFL).



In addition to in-person services at Fleet and Family Support Centers (FFSCs) the vWFL program offers online training workshops, mobile training delivery, and one-on-one consultations supporting commands, Sailors, and their families, especially in geographically isolated and remote locations.

Daily Navy life can be challenging especially while stationed in remote duty stations or underway that can have a negative effect of morale and readiness upon commands, Sailors, and their families. The Navy's vWFL program has responded to the needs of the force by adding a remote and virtual programs to provide multiple service and support options. This program has expanded its reach with highly trained professionals to provide online services to Sailors and their eligible family members regardless of their location.

vWFL is a Navy-approved platform to assist commands, Sailors, and their families with training and education to assist with everything from transition assistance, personal finance, life skills, to everyday Navy life. You may have questions about the Virtual Work and Family Life program. This page includes a series of questions with answers that may help you understand the vWFL program better.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What is the virtual Work & Family Life program?

A: The virtual Work and Family Life program is an added program to meet an increased demand to access our prevention and resilience-building education and training programs and continue to provide high-quality services to commands, Sailors, and Navy families who are underway, stationed in geographically isolated and remote locations, and don't have access to FFSC programs that are offered at most Navy installations.

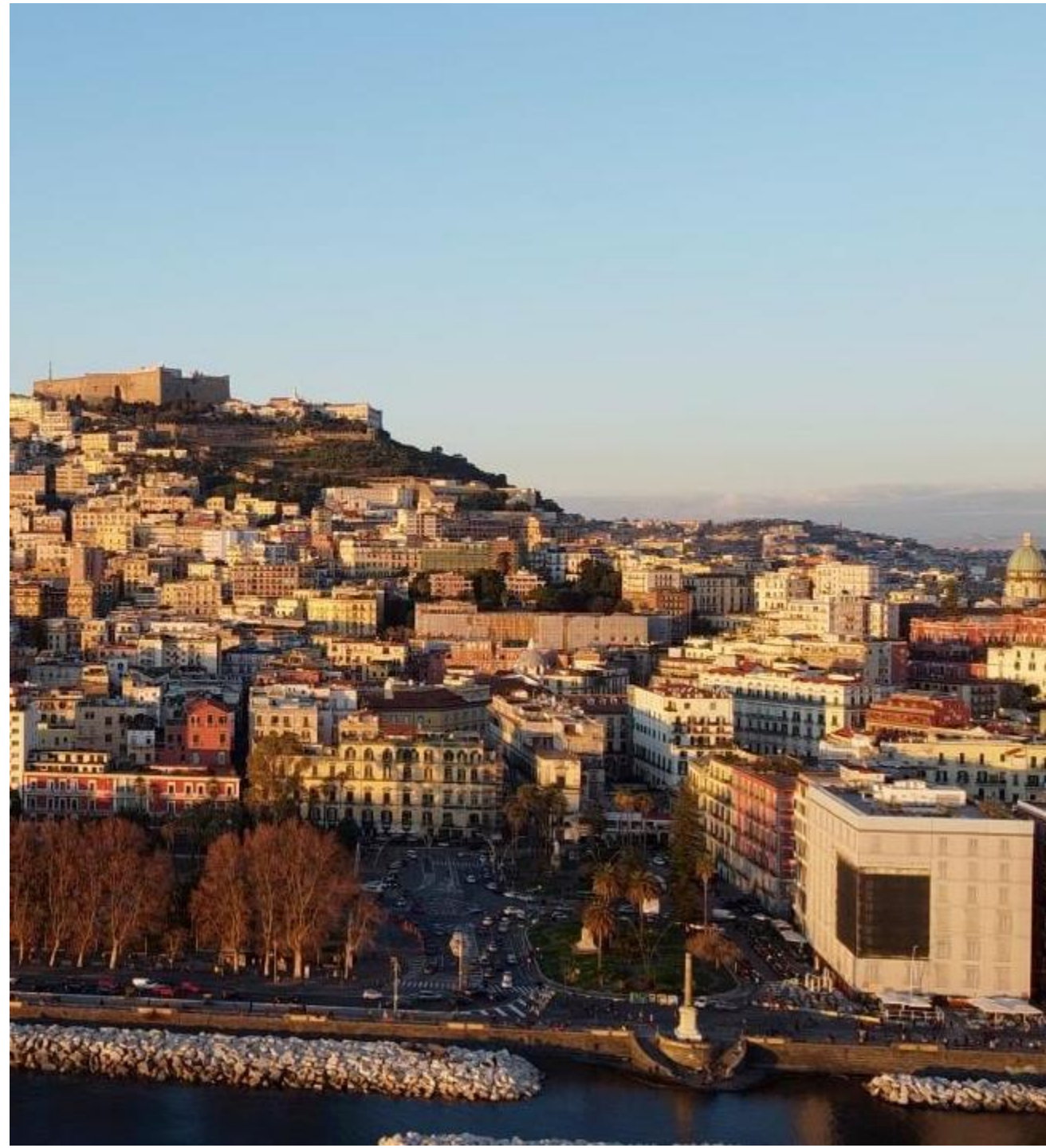
