## Community Liaison

Has there been any progress for EU dependent spouses living on Support Site to register at the local Commune?

- We're happy to announce that in early June 2025, we made progress with the Mayor of Gricignano's office regarding the verification of EU dependent spouses residing on Support Site.
- To ensure accurate residency information, the Chief Officer of the Gricignano Municipal Police will be granted access to Support Site for verification purposes. We are in the process of issuing a base access letter, valid for one year, to facilitate this.
- A housing POC has been identified and will serve as the primary point of contact between the base and the City of Gricignano on this matter.
- The Municipal Police will work directly with the housing POC to coordinate and arrange residency verification activities.
- This collaborative effort will streamline the verification process.
- As soon as coordination is complete with the city council, we will update the community with contact information for residency verification.

## Housing

In the Support Site housing bathrooms, we deal with a lot of mildew and mold because the matte paint is very porous. Since anti-fungal paint is being used in renovation projects (as mentioned in renovations of the Capodichino and Support Site gyms), can this be used to potentially reduce the mold buildup in on-base housing bathrooms?

- In accordance with the Housing maintenance contract, which stipulates that "all paints and colors shall be mold/mildew resistant," Housing Quality Assurance Examiners have confirmed that the paint used by Mirabella during Change of Occupancy maintenance and touch-up work is Premar brand, type Gran Sasso. The Material Safety Data Sheet for this paint confirms that it is highly breathable and ideal for preventing mold and mildew formation.
