It's PCS Season...New to Naples, ensure Tricare enrollment is up-to-date

Enroll to: TRICARE Prime Overseas (if AD and ADOS Reservists onboard for more than 30 days)

3 Ways to enroll: Online: milConnect website: Click "Benefits" tab, then click "Beneficiary Web Enrollment (BWE)"

Phone: Call Regional Contractor at 800-915-994 (toll free) or +44 20-8762-8384. Select option 4 to speak to the Global TRICARE Service Center

In person: Complete the TRICARE Prime Overseas Enrollment form. Bring the form along with a copy of your orders to the Capo Clinic. Capo Clinic will deliver the forms to the TRICARE Office at Support Site. Or stop by the Support Site TRICARE office.

Heat Cramps:

Usually occurs during strenuous activity. The body's salt and fluid levels are depleted by excessive sweating. Rest and drink fluids (water or electrolyte containing sports drinks, *not energy drinks*). *If symptoms don't improve, seek medical attention.*

Heat Exhaustion:

More serious than heat cramps. Symptoms can include headache, nausea, profuse sweating, dizziness or weakness. Stop activity, give fluids if able and seek medical attention to include call emergency services if severe.

Heat Stroke:

Most serious of heat-related injuries; can be fatal. Symptoms include very high body temperature, confusion, altered mental status, loss of consciousness, slurred speech and seizures.

Hot, dry skin or profuse sweating can occur.

Call emergency services immediately.

HEAT INJURY PREVENTION

1. Hydrate or die. It's not just a saying. Prep for the heat by drinking plenty of water in advance and while you're at it (maybe some sports drinks too; but not energy drinks). Eat something too. Your body needs fuel in all that heat.

2. Signs of impending trouble:

Heat cramps → heat exhaustion → heat stroke is the typical progression for heat-related injuries.

Prevention is key, but if preventative measures weren't enough, early recognition of symptoms followed by quick action is vital to stop symptoms from getting worse.

Heat exhaustion symptoms include — Cool, moist skin with goose bumps when in the heat, heavy sweating, faintness, dizziness, fatigue, weak rapid pulse, low blood pressure upon standing, muscle cramps, nausea, headache.

Heat stroke symptoms include — Core body temp of 104°F or higher, confusion, agitation, slurred speech, irritability, seizures, skin feels dry and hot to the touch, nausea, vomiting, rapid shallow breathing, racing heart rate, throbbing headache.

3. What to do. If you or someone you're with has symptoms, stop all activity and rest, move to a cooler place, drink cool water or sports drinks and seek medical attention if symptoms get worse or don't improve within an hour. If heat victim becomes confused, distressed, loses consciousness or is unable to drink, seek immediate medical attention. 
