Safety Department

Decorating and Electrical Safety:

- Inspect cords, lights, and decorations for cracks, breaks, or frays before use
- Use Indoor lights indoors and outdoor lights outdoors; don't overload outlets or daisy chain electrical devices.
- Keep real trees watered and away from heat sources.
- Turn off lights before bed or leaving home.
- Use a stable ladder and a spotter when hanging decorations.

Fire Safety and Cooking:

- #1 cause of holiday fires: Unattended Cooking; #2 cause = Misuse of electrical equipment
- If frying a turkey, do so outdoors, away from structures. **Never** drop an unthawed turkey into hot oil.
- Give space heaters 3 feet (1m) of clearance on all sides and clear of anything flammable.
- Check your smoke and CO detectors

Safe Gift-Giving:

- Buy age appropriate; avoid small parts, button batteries, and magnets for young children.
- Purchase electronic items only from reputable vendors.
- Properly label gifts before shipping, especially if they contain batteries.

Cold Weather Precautions:

- Dress in layers, stay dry, and watch for hypothermia/frostbite.
- Heat homes safely; be careful with fireplaces and electrical equipment.
- Check on neighbors and shipmates during cold snaps.

Holiday Travel Safety:

- Pre-plan routes and check weather; **Never** drive while fatigued or impaired.
- Inspect tires, fluids, and wipers before trips. Make sure your vehicle is equipped with required safety gear.
- Buckle up – Every trip, every time.
- When flying, allow extra time and keep emergency contacts current.

Community Well-Being:

- Manage stress, rest, hydrate, and ask for help when needed.
- Look out for each other – Mission readiness starts with safety.

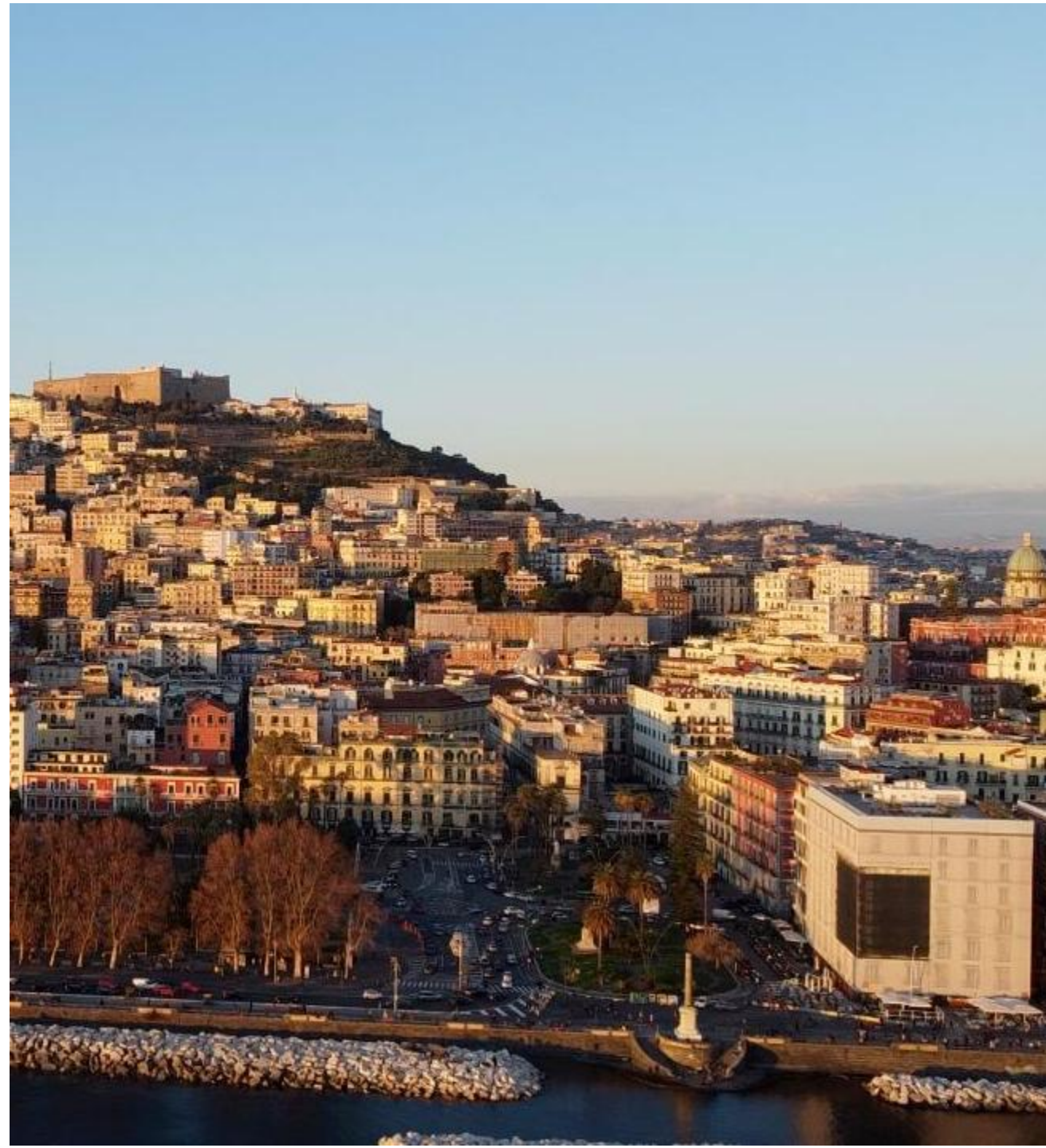
