

EMS Factsheet NSA Naples

Naval Support Activity (NSA) Naples has an Environmental Management System (EMS).

All personnel at this installation - civilian, military, and contractors - are included in the EMS.

Per regulation, you may be asked about EMS during an audit. Along with following environmental rules and regulations, here's what you need to know about the program:

1) "What is EMS?" - EMS stands for Environmental Management System. EMS is a set of processes and procedures that allows NSA Naples to analyze, control, and reduce its impact on the environment.

EMS focuses on:

COMPLIANCE – NSA Naples strives to pro-active and designed the EMS to optimize mission readiness through strict compliance with regulations and instructions

CONTINUAL IMPROVEMENT - Every member of the NSA Naples community is charged with the responsibility to continuously improve operational activities and prevent negative environmental impacts.

POLLUTION PREVENTION - NSA Naples is committed to eliminating pollutant releases and minimizing waste volume
