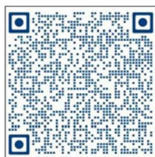

NJP RESULTS: 3 November 25

- E4 found guilty at NJP for violation of UCMJ Article 113 (Drunken or reckless operation of a vehicle) and Article 114 (2 specifications-reckless endangerment). Member was awarded reduction in rank to E3; Forfeiture of ½ pay per month for 1 month (suspended for 6 month); and written letter of reprimand.
