From your NC Office: REMINDER:

"The Targeted Re-entry Program (TRP) aims to retain the experience and training of the Navy's highest performing Service members who might be lost to separation. It benefits both the Navy and the Service member by providing a path to continued service for exceptional leaders with valuable skills needed in the Navy. Eligible TRP participants can pursue personal or professional goals outside full-time Navy constraints and are provided an expedited return to active duty (ACDU) if desired. Commanding officers (COs) may recommend awarding a golden ticket or silver ticket to these officer and enlisted Service members. Golden ticket recipients are guaranteed a return to duty within 1 year of separation, while silver ticket recipients may return within 2 years, subject to the Navy's needs. Eligibility for TRP is based on officer and enlisted eligibility criteria. For more information read NAVADMIN 047/18, MILPERSMAN 1001-260, or contact your Career Counselor's!

TA will be limited to a fiscal year cap of 18 semester hours, 27 quarter hours, or 270 clock hours. Unused hours do not carry over to the next fiscal year. Sailors with remaining FY25 Tuition Assistance (TA) funds need to submit applications and obtain command approval before September 23rd. For more information please visit MyNavyEducation."
