## **ENERGY CONSERVATION**

#### **Actual Costs**

FY21 Electricity costs at NSA Naples totaled ~ \$ 11M, FY22 YTD ~ \$23M.

#### A 450% increase!

#### Lights

 Use windows to allow natural daylight when available, and turn off lights for unoccupied spaces.

#### Heating/cooling

 When feasible turn "off" fans, A/C and heaters when the room or house is empty. Keep doors and windows closed when the heat or A/C is on. Repair any air leaks to the outside, including missing weather stripping. Properly set the thermostat in order to avoid excessive heating or cooling.

#### Vampire Loads

- Electronics Turn off non essential equipment when not in use: chargers, monitors, TV's, printers, laptops, coffee makers, etc..



**Cooking oil disposal sites** 





## **DRINKING WATER**

#### **Things to Know:**

- Water at every facility is regularly tested. Information and results of the tests can be found in the consumer confidence reports published each year by July 1st for every facility (except Gaeta port) are available at:
- Consumer Confidence Reports can be found on CNIC website: https://www.cnic.navy.mil/regions/cnreurafswa/installations/nsa\_naples/om/environmental\_support/drinking\_water\_consumer\_confidence\_report.html
- Bottled water is not required for on-base residents, and is not provided.

#### **Drinking water off-base**

• Tested by the local authorities to Italian drinking water standards. It is not tested to USEPA standards and we cannot verify the test results; therefore, tap water offbase is considered "not fit for human consumption". Use Bottled Water.

#### Irrigation water (ditches and sprinklers)

 It is NOT fit for human or pet consumption or recreational purposes at any NSA Naples installation. It should be used only for irrigation.



## DRINKING WATER

## What can I do if I experience water issues?

- On Base Contact the housing department trouble line for general water complaints or issues.
- Off Base Contact your Landlord
- Water characteristics in your new duty station and residence can differ from your previous location. This could include the taste, color, and smell. These can differ based on where you are residing.
- Chlorine Smell Chlorine Dioxide







## **BOTTLED WATER**

All off-base housing lease agreements through NSA Naples Housing Office include a requirement for Landlords to provide containerized (bottled) water from a Navy-approved vendor.

4 Liters per person per day

For a family of 5, this = 20 L Daily  $\rightarrow$  600 L Monthly  $\rightarrow$  7,300 L annually

# Things you can do to help prevent the possibility of vapor intrusion into a home you select:

- The higher you live, the less risk you have from vapor intrusion. Look for homes where the living space is higher than the ground floor.
- Avoid living in basements and when practical, ventilate the home by opening windows to increase the rate of air exchange.

### Soil Awareness

- Arsenic is naturally present in the volcanic soils in the Naples area. wash-up after playing and working in the soil.
- Thoroughly wash all fresh fruits and vegetables prior to eating or cooking.
   Immune-compromised people should consume only cooked fruits and vegetables. These food safety guidelines apply no matter where you live in the world.
- For some people increased awareness may be appropriate for some fruits like strawberries and root vegetables which have higher water absorption rates. As they receive water through irrigation and the irrigation water may be contaminated.



#### Economy Housing Entitlements – Health Assessments

"The landlord hereby authorizes the tenant to have the necessary tests carried out at any time to verify the quality of the water supplied to the home, as well as that of the soil and air. The landlord will ensure that the unit meets all Italian standards and regulations, and authorizes the tenant to test environmental qualities. The landlord's failure to fulfill these obligations will result in the termination of the lease, according to Art. 1456 of Italian Civil Code."

- Lease language entitles tenants to have all necessary tests carried out at any time to check the quality of water supplied to the residence, as well as that of soil and air (including radon).
- Landlords will ensure that the unit meets all **Italian** standards and regulations, and authorizes the tenant to test environmental qualities.
- The landlord's failure to fulfill these obligations will result in the termination of the lease. (Art. 1456 of Italian Civil Code.)
- In the event the tenant feels the result of testing indicates the leased property does not meet the Italian standards and regulations, the tenant will contact the Housing Office to discuss ways forward.
- Best Practice: ask the Landlord to provide documentation of standards compliance before entering into the lease if this is a concern for you.
