# DRINKING WATER (DW)



- NSA Naples Public Works Department and USNH Naples-Preventive Medicine monitor Drinking Water (DW) quality at all NSA Naples installations, including on-base housing.
- Testing conforms with US EPA and Italian DW Methods, and Results are compared to US EPA DW Standards
- Results for Capodochino, Support Site, SATCOM Lago Patria, Carney Park, and Gaeta Olde Mill Inn, are in compliance with US EPA DW standards, and the water is safe to drink.
- Tap water at NSAN Gaeta is not fit for human consumption
  - Bottled water is supplied to NSAND Gaeta.
- Note: Irrigation water is not potable and is not fit for human consumption at any NSA Naples installation

## Drinking water off-base

- Tested by the local authorities to Italian drinking water standards. It is not tested to USEPA standards and we cannot verify the test results; therefore, tap water off-base is considered “not fit for human consumption”. Use Bottled Water.



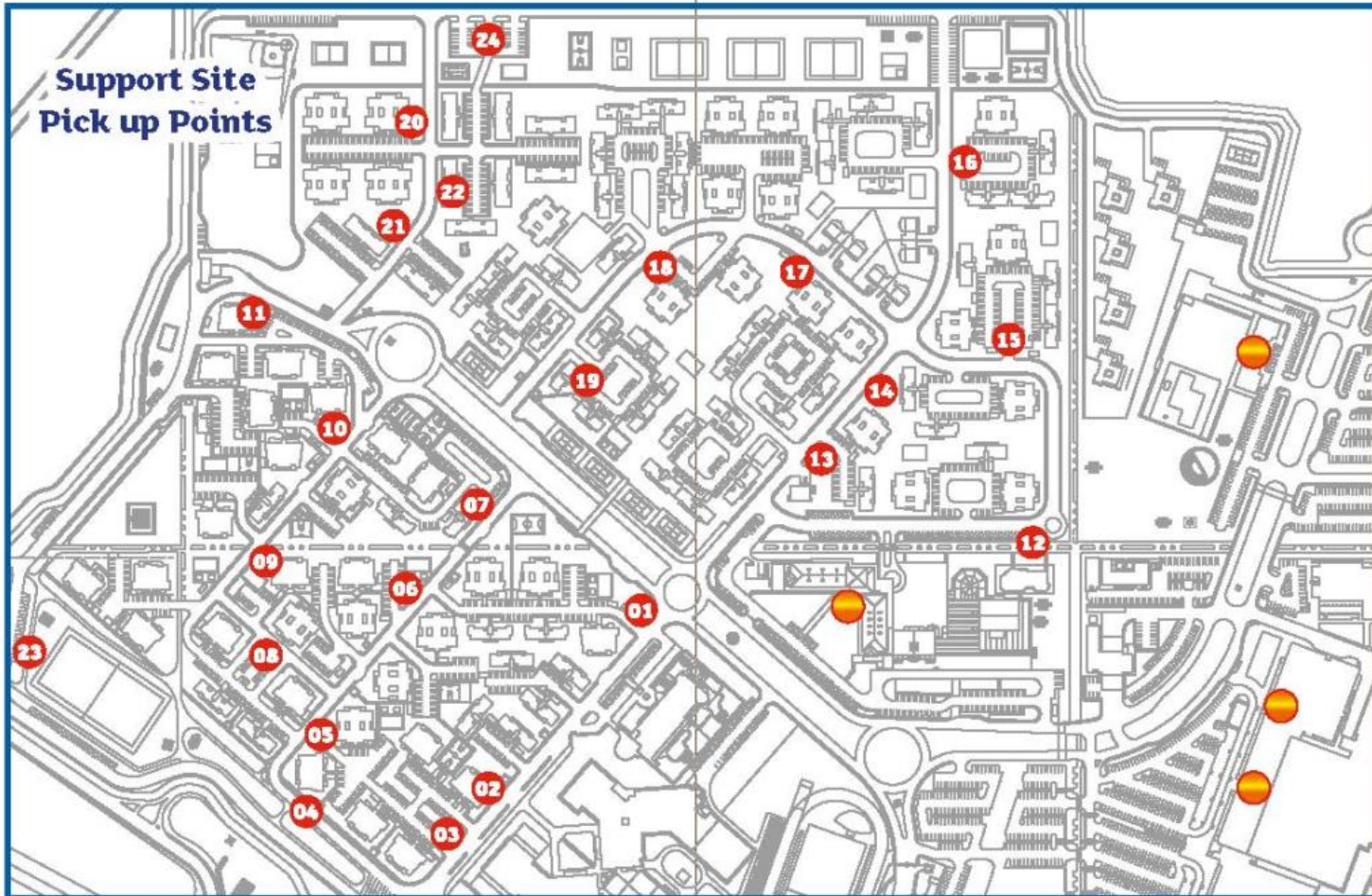

**Household hazwaste** - like paints, bleach, etc is handled differently. Same for bulky waste. Call Housing trouble desk, 081-811-4285/6 or DSN 629-4285/6 (Hours Mon-Fri, 07:30-16:30) .

For those that live in town ask your land lord.

**Cooking Oil** - Collection containers for used cooking oil are located at Pick Up Points # 2, 5, 9, 10, 13, 15, 16 and 17

**Batteries** – Collection containers for used batteries are located at the Fitness Center, DeCA, NEX and NEX Mini-Mart.
