NSF Deveselu Pre-Departure Checklist

Below are steps to take prior to your departure from the U.S. or current duty station. Also listed are tips to aid in a smooth transition to life in Romania. The NEX Mini-Mart in the HDF has some of these items, but can be sold out of them at times.

Electronics

- o European Adaptors
- Amazon Prime account (offers free shipping on select items)
- WiFi is available in your room:
 - \$49.95/month three devices
 - o \$34.95/month two devices
 - \$26.95/month one device
 - \$7.95/day one device
 - \$14.95/week one device
- Unlock your phone before coming out
 - \circ This will more than likely mean you will need to pay the phone off in its entirety
 - Some phone plans in the US are structured so the customer pays the balance of the phone via monthly payments as opposed to one charge up front.
 - There are 3 to 4 very affordable and viable wireless carriers here in Romania with a wide range of plans. Most personnel purchase a plan after arriving in Romania.
- If you have a smartphone, download an offline navigation app such as "Here" or "Navigator" then download the Romania map within the app.

Uniforms

- We have a limited number of uniform items at the NEX, come out with a spare of all the items you might need
- Plenty of boot socks
- Extra uniform belts (recommend 3 for MAs)

Personal

Clothes for all seasons (wide temperature range throughout the year -10degF to 100degF)
European Clothes run much slimmer than American retail. If you are over 6ft and/or over 200lbs, it can be very difficult to find clothing items that fit.
