

- If you are a military voter, military spouse, or eligible family member retaining residency in your home state, complete and submit your Federal Post Card Application (FPCA) form as soon as possible
- This form will register you to vote and request absentee ballots for the remainder of 2022.

Voting Assistance Information and Training

• The Federal Voting Assistance Program (FVAP) recommends that all military members and their eligible family members away from their voting jurisdiction, as well as U.S. citizens overseas, send in an FPCA each year to ensure receipt of absentee ballots for all federal office elections.
